Job: Kingsway Road Drainage Improvement Project

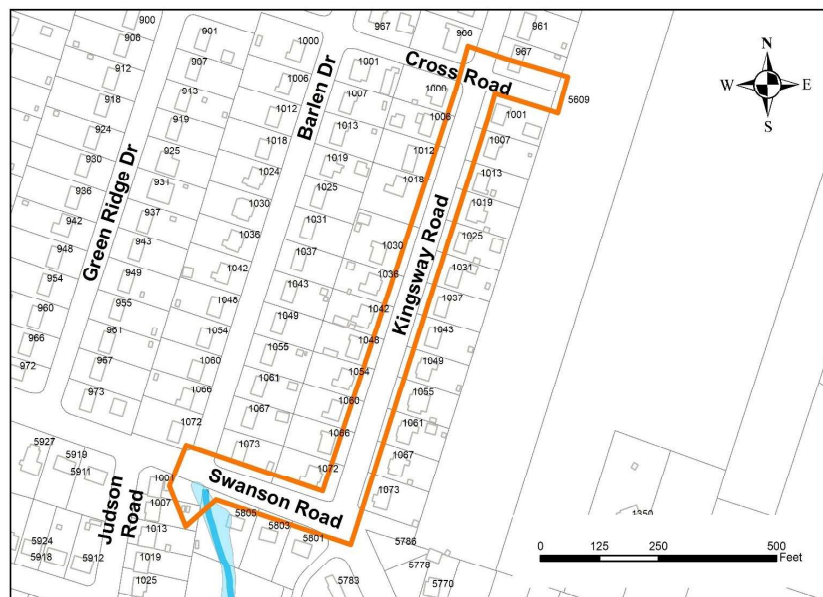
Location: Warwick Neighborhood

Project Introduction

This project will address drainage issues with the existing infrastructure along Kingsway Road, which mainly consists of ditches and culverts. This project will enhance drainage infrastructure for improved public health and safety, and hydraulic performance.

The project area is illustrated below and generally includes:

- Cross Street to Kingsway Road;
- Kingsway Road from Cross Street to Swanson Road; and
- Swanson Road from Kingsway Road to outfall across from Barlen Drive

Survey & Preliminary Design: August 2019 through October 2019 (Cardinal Survey and Accumark)

Engineering Design: August 2019 through October 2020

Public meetings will be held to present the proposed improvements and to receive feedback. The times and locations of these public meetings will be announced as the project progresses.

Project Duration:

The field survey and engineering design are anticipated to be complete in October 2020.

Before construction begins, a letter will be sent to adjacent property owners to notify the neighborhood of the construction start date.
